



CANINE

INDICATIONS:

- Weight maintenance following a weight loss programme
- Dogs that are prone to obesity
- Diabetes mellitus
- Hyperlipidaemia linked to excess weight
- Colitis
- Constipation

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Pregnancy, lactation, growth
- Chronic diseases that require an increased energy intake

FEEDING DURATION:

For diabetic dogs and dogs that are prone to being overweight (neutered, breed predisposition etc.), Weight Control Canine should be fed for the pet's lifetime.



• Rich in protein and containing L-carnitine to help combat excess weight gain which contributes to insulin resistance.



• Chondroitin sulphate and glucosamine help to maintain joint mobility.



• Mixing cereals of low glycaemic index (barley, corn) in conjunction with the gelling action of psyllium mucilages reduces postprandial hyperglycaemia.



• The synergistic antioxidant complex neutralises free radicals, helps maintain healthy DNA and promotes health of the immune system.

FURTHER INFORMATION:

Diabetes mellitus promotes oxidative stress, which in turn favours the development of diabetes-associated chronic complications (Opara 2002).

Lutein and antioxidants play an essential role in **sensitivity to insulin** (Evans et al, 2003).

INGREDIENTS:

Dehydrated poultry meat, barley, maize flour, vegetable fibres, beet pulp, maize gluten, hydrolysed animal proteins, animal fats, minerals, yeasts, fish oil, psyllium husks and seeds, Fructo-Oligo-Saccharides (FOS), taurine, hydrolysed crustaceans (source of glucosamine), marigold extract (source of lutein), L-carnitine, hydrolysed cartilage (source of chondroitin).

RECOMMENDED DAILY INTAKE:

It is recommended to divide the daily intake into 2 meals.
